CHORUS GROUPS

Offering four distinct performing groups: Community Chorus, Chamber Singers, Middle School Chorus, and Youth Chorus, TCCS provides singers of all ages and skill levels an opportunity to participate and keep singing!

- Community Chorus -

The Community Chorus is open to High School aged individuals and older. Auditions are not required to join. Everyone is welcome, no matter their musical skill, background or experience.

- Chamber Singers -

The Chamber Singers is an audition group that focuses on more rigorous musical selections, usually consisting of classical works by composers such as Mozart, Handel, Rutter, and many more.

- Middle School & Youth Choruses -

The Middle School Chorus (grades 6-10) and Youth Chorus (grades K-5) provide young students who love to sing the opportunity to improve vocal skills and expand their knowledge of music theory. All skill levels are welcome!

STUDENT OUTREACH

TCCS prides itself on mentoring musically talented youth through our Scholarship and High School Stipend Programs.

The *Scholarship Program* supports graduating high school students in their college study of music or music education. Through private donations and one dollar from each concert ticket sold, the TCCS scholarship fund has awarded over \$45,000.00 to graduating students attending schools in Martin and St. Lucie Counties. The hope is that these recipients will make musical contributions to their communities in years to come.

The *High School Stipend Program* offers talented high school juniors and seniors the opportunity to rehearse and perform in concerts with TCCS and in return they receive a stipend. Interested students apply for the program and are selected by the Director. On average, four to eight students participate in this program per concert session.
